Each of the following topics requires a short answer response to the related questions. The answers must be in paragraph form and must be between 200 and 300 words in length. Because of some overlap between the scholarship questions below and Class Afloat school application documents, you may choose to submit the same document to fulfil both requirements.

- 1. Experiential learning opportunities typically occur in outdoor environments and/ or involve working in a team setting. Whether playing on a team, doing community service, working as a crew on a sailing vessel, or working as a camp counselor, physical vigour, willingness to engage with new situations and uncertainty, and a spirit of co-operation are required of the participant. How do you feel you would be able to contribute to the Class Afloat program? What specific experiences in your life have prepared you for this?
- 2. A) Why do you feel it is important for you to participate in the Class Afloat program?
- 2. B) What, in your opinion, would be your impact on or contribution to your fellow participants and the program in general?
- 3. Have you ever engaged in a service commitment? What do you expect such experiences mean to a student engaged in the program to which you are applying? Examples of service activities include but are not limited to: clubs, sports teams, social advocacy groups, religious groups, support groups, health care support, etc. Each requires commitment and time.
